

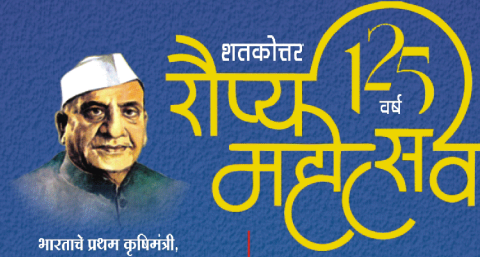

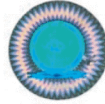

- 3.1.1 In addition to the above three science subjects, students of B.Sc. - I, have to study 02 languages :
- Compulsory English and
 - Compulsory Language i.e. Marathi, OR Hindi OR Supplementary English.
- 3.1.2 Vocational Computer Application, Vocational Bio-technology & B.C.A. are on No Grant Basis.
- 3.1.3 B. Voc. Courses are on Nongrant Basis.
- 3.1.4 For B.Sc. II & III, B.C.A. II & III fresh admissions to outside students are subject to vacancy and as per reservation quota.
- 3.1.5 As per University Notification, Environmental Studies is a compulsory subject for all students of B.Sc./B.C.A. Part II students.



Eligibility For Admission

(As per SGB Amravati University Ordinance for admission to B.Sc.)

For Under Graduate B.Sc. Course

1) The Students passing H.S.S.C. Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics shall offer following subjects at B.Sc. Part-I Examination

- i) English and any one of the following languages Marathi, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit and Supplementary English.
- ii) Three optional subjects atleast one subject from the following groups be selected.

● **Group A :-** Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry, Petro-chemical Science, Electronics, Mathematics.

● **Group B :-** Physics, Geology, Statistics, Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology and Geography.

The Students passing H.S.S.C. Examination with Chemistry and Biology shall offer following subjects :-

- i) English and any one of the following languages. Marathi, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit, Supplementary English.
- ii) Chemistry
- iii) Two optional subjects from the following group be selected.

● **Group C :-** Botany, Zoology, Biochemistry, Geography, Fisheries, Environmental Science, Microbiology, Geology, Food Science, Industrial Microbiology, Biotechnology and Appiculture.

For Vocational subjects sanctioned by U.G.C. there shall be following scheme of Combinaton of subjects :-

- 1) Students with Mathematics at H.S.S.C. Examination shall select two subjects from Group D and one from Group F.
- 2) Students passing with Biology, at H.S.S.C. Examination shall select two subjects from Group E and one from Group F.

● **Group D :** Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Electronics, Statistics, Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology, Geology.

● **Group E :** Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Geology, Geography, Environmental Science, Industrial Microbiology, Biochemistry.

● **Group F:** Biological Techniques and Specimen Preparation, Industrial Chemistry, Instrumentation, Computer Application, Seed Technology, Industrial Fish and Fisheries, Computer Maintenance, Biotechnology and other Vocational subjects proposed by U.G.C. from time to time shall be included in Group F.

The students passing HSSC examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics shall have the option of opting Bioinformatics subject with any one subject from Group-G and any one subject from Group-H.



- **Group G** : Botany, Zoology, Bio-Chemistry, Microbiology, Industrial Microbiology, Biotechnology.
- **Group H** : Chemistry, Physics, Electronics, Statistics, Geology, Mathematics, Computer Science.

II) The students passing H.S.S.C. examination (M.C.V.C. stream) with technical trades mentioned in column No. 2 of the following table shall be eligible for admission to the B.Sc. Part-I course in the optional subjects mentioned in column No. 3 of the said table as per the scheme given in Group A to H.

Eligibility For Admission

● **Admission to BCA Course**

In the case of the Bachelor of Computer Application Par-I, Semester-I Examination, student should have passed not less than one academic year previously the 12th standard Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education with English and other modern Indian Languages of subject. I.T. together with Mathematics or three years Diploma course in Electronics and Computer Engg. or +2 level minimum competency vocational course in Electronics Technology or students passing the 12th Standard Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education and offering Vocational stream with Mathematics shall be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Computer Application Part-I, Semester-I course or an Examination recognized as equivalent thereto in such subjects and with such standards of attainments as may be prescribed.

Admission to Post Graduate M.Sc. Courses

- Admission to P.G. Courses is as per Ordinance No. 4 of 2008.

Admission to B. Voc. Courses

● **Admission in Forensic Science**

Minimum qualification - should have passed H.S.S.C. examination of Maharashtra State or C.B.S.E. or I.C.S.E. Board of Higher Secondary Education in science discipline with Chemistry as main subject.

● **Admission in Data Analytics**

Minimum qualification - should have passed H.S.S.C. examination of Maharashtra State or C.B.S.E. or I.C.S.E. Board of Higher Secondary Education in science discipline with Mathematics / Statistics as main subject.

Minimum Qualification

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree or above from any faculty with subject like IT/Computer Science / Computer Application / Bioinformatics / Statistics / Mathematics/ Electronics/ Etc/ Physics/ Chemistry/ Biochemistry/ Microbiology/ Biotechnology / Forensic Science as one of the subject, BCA , MCA, B. Voc. in Forensic Science BVoc in data analytics, LLB, LLM or any other degree equivalent.

● **Admission to PG Diploma in Content Writing**

Minimum Qualification

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree in any subject.

● **Admission to PG Diploma in Soil Testing (Proposed - 2023-24)**

Minimum Qualification

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree or above from faculty of science with subject from Chemical Sciences / Life Sciences / Geology. Also the Candidates passing bachelor's degree from Agriculture or any other degree equivalent.

● **Admission to PG Diploma in Data Analysis (Proposed - 2023-24)**

Minimum Qualification

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree or above from any faculty with subject like IT/Computer Science / Computer Application / Bioinformatics / Statistics / Mathematics/ Electronics/ Etc/ Physics/ Chemistry/ Biochemistry/ Microbiology/ Biotechnology / Forensic Science as one of the subject, BCA , MCA, B. Voc. in Forensic Science BVoc in data analytics, LLB, LLM or any other degree equivalent.



- 3.1.6 For B. Sc.-III Sem VI Mathematics students, the college offers only paper XII i.e. Special Theory of Relativity as an optional paper.

3.2 Admission Procedure :

- 3.2.1 All admissions are online. For submission of online application form, visit college website-www.shivajiscamt.ac.in/www.shivajiscamt.org.
- 3.2.2 The programme for admission for the current session will be displayed on the Notice Board/college website-www.shivajiscamt.ac.in/www.shivajiscamt.org. Applicants are advised to keep themselves informed of the various notices that are displayed on the Notice Board/college website from time to time.
- 3.2.3 Admissions are subject to the eligibility norms of the S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati.
- 3.2.4 At the time of admission students has to bring a printout of submitted application form alongwith the attested copies of following documents as well as the original documents for verification :
- School/College Leaving Certificate (T.C.)
 - Statement of marks of the last examination passed/failed.
 - Migration Certificate in case of a student who has passed the last examination from a Board other than Maharashtra State Board or a University other than S.G.B. Amravati University.
 - Caste certificate, Validity and Non Creamy Layer.
 - Aadhar Card
- 3.2.5 Students who pass the qualifying examination from any other University and desire to seek admission should submit an eligibility certificate.
- 3.2.6 Applicants who have a break in education should submit a gap certificate in the form of a court affidavit stating the reason for the gap.

7.2 Academic Results :

**SECTION - 8 : Rules & Regulations and code of conduct for students**

- 8.1** Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.

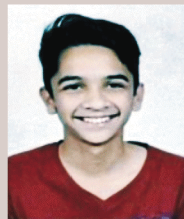
