(3) In addition to the above two combinations of subjects (Group of two subjects), as per the Resolution of SGB Amravati University by the Hon'ble VC vide Sec 12 (7) of the MPU 2016 and Direction/Ordinance as approved by the Faculties in its meetings dated 22.4.2024, Academic Council under section 12(7), the students should select the subjects and activities like; Internship/ Co-curricular/Community Engagement, etc. from each vertical as applicable to earn the corresponding **Mandatory Credits** for completion of the level. ### **● Admission to PG Diploma in Content Writing**

**7.2 Academic Results :**

College results from last five years are consistently good which are the basis of its strong foundation. As a consequence a large number of students are getting attracted to this college for admission.

**7.3 Attendance :**

In order to qualify for the Board/University examinations, concessions and scholarships students must attend atleast 75% of the lectures (including practicals) delivered in each subject.

## **SECTION - 8 : Rules & Regulations and code of conduct for students**

- 8.1** Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
- 8.2** The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board of the college.
- 8.3** The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case a student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
- 8.4** Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per University rules.
- 8.5** No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
- 8.6** All new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the University. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the University. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.
- 8.7** Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indisciplined manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.

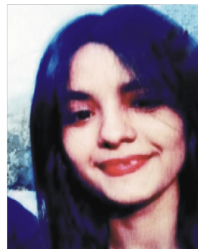
