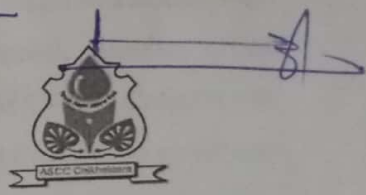

**SHRI SHIVAJI SCIENCE COLLEGE AMRAVATI** evolved under Shri Shivaji Education Society as a premier institute for imparting formal education in science stream and affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati. Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati was established in 1958 with a combination of faculties namely Science, Arts, Commerce, Law and Agriculture, and was separated as a Science Faculty in 1969. The college takes pride to declare that it has indeed grown from a seedling into a tree that has not only sheltered thousands of youngsters but has also molded them into great personalities now scattered across the globe.

The institution received its first accreditation from NAAC in 2001 with an "A" (Four Star) grade. In 2008, it was accredited again with an "A" Grade (Very Good) and a CGPA of 3.10. Similarly, in 2015, it received another "A" Grade with a CGPA of 3.13. Once again, NAAC has endorsed the quality of this college by adjudging it as an "A+" Grade institution with a CGPA of 3.42 in the Fourth Cycle of accreditation. It was indeed a great achievement. The College has also earned a special reputation for being conferred with the status of a "College with Potential for Excellence", by the UGC and also sanctioned FIST from the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India in 2016. The college is included in NIRF (Rank Band 151 - 200) for consecutive two years 2022 and 2023. In 2023, college has been recognized by DBT as a STAR College (Strengthening Component). Another proud achievement for the college occurred in 2024 when the institution secured the PM USHA: Component-3 Grant for College Strengthening. SGBAU has identified our college as a "Lead College" to guide and help other colleges in the university area for quality enhancement and mentoring for NAAC assessment. The Govt. of Maharashtra has recognized the college as a Centre of Excellence in 2024. The department of Environmental Science was established in 1999. The department conducted various extension, outreach and cocurricular programs such as Air, Noise Pollution Monitoring, PUC Camp, E- waste management, promotion of Environmental Awareness, Microbiological Testing of Water Samples, Study of Heavy Metals in Ground Water and workshops for sustainable development. The Central Instrumentation Centre (C.I.C.) of the college has the facilities to carry out various analytical and spectroscopic measurements, chromatography and sample characterization by visual and photographic analysis.



**ARTS, SCIENCE AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, CHIKHALDARA, DIST. AMRAVATI INDIA**, evolved under Sipna Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Amravati was established in the year 1996 for the purpose of holistic development of the people in the remote Melghat area of Maharashtra. The college has a CGPA of 3.22 with A grade in the 4<sup>th</sup> NAAC Assessment. Melghat region is hampered by innumerable problems and difficulties and specially lagged behind so far higher education is concerned. Arts, Science and Commerce College, Chikhadara, Distt. Amravati came into existence in 1996 with an intention to impart higher education to the tribal at their very door step and ensure their wellbeing, growth and safety. The college offers degree courses like B.A., B.Sc. and B.com with traditional and advanced subjects. The College was the first in Maharashtra to launch the advanced subjects like Petrochemical Science, Food Science at B.Sc. level. The college came in to existence under special provisions of Maharashtra State. Being a college in tribal region it is 100% aided college since the year of establishment. The college is aptly equipped with all the infrastructural facilities, qualified and devoted staff and student support services. One of the proud achievements of our institution is receiving the PM UShA: Component-3 (Grant for College Strengthening.)

The Department of Environmental Science was established in 1996 at undergraduate level after Post Graduate in Environmental Science. Department has been conducting extension activities such as establishing Chikhaldara Weather Observation and Information Center (WOIC); a facility to disseminate weather data to researchers, Government Developmental Projects, Agricultural Planning etc. Another Departmental activity is Development of Grass Meadows in Protected Forest areas of India. Hereafter referred to as confirming their interest in the development of cooperation in the field of research and academia to their mutual advantage, have agreed as follows.

**Art. 1**

- This Agreement/Linkage sets out the purpose, terms and conditions of MOU between Arts, Science and Commerce College, Chikhaldara Dist. Amravati.

**Art. 2**

- This agreement pertains to teaching, research, activities and student exchange /internship.

**Art. 3**

- Both the organization agree on the following forms of cooperation:

**In the field of Education:**

- To exchange experience in teaching methods.
- To exchange staff members for the purpose of giving lectures, taking part in seminars etc.

**In the field of Research:**

- To conduct joint research projects / coordinate research studies.
- To organize joint seminars, conferences, symposia etc.

**In the field of Student Exchange:**

- To create/deploy students for a period of one semester of its part, or for a time needed to conduct specific project/survey, practical training, or preparation of thesis.
- To carry out joint research programs by students.
- To deploy students for practical training/internship as per New Education Policy-2020.

**In the field of Consultancy:**

- To provide analytical services, exchange of technologies.
- To conduct Academic/Environmental and Energy Auditing an opportunity for making use of the tangible and intangible resources available with the college.
- To provide Biodiversity Conservation, Habitat Management services and exchange of Knowledge.
- Collaborative work on Field Ecological Study.

**Art. 4**

- To achieve specific objectives and tasks under this Agreement, the internal organizational units shall design a detailed working plan. This plan shall refer to this Agreement and shall provide for the rules of cooperation such as, time and period of the parties 'representatives' visits, use of analytical facilities available in the college, financial obligations if any, protection of intellectual property rights etc.

**Art. 5**

- The parties agree to take necessary steps, ensuring mutual support for the purpose of meeting the objectives of MOU, collaboration / linkages.
- This agreement does not entail any financial consequences for either of the parties.

**Art. 6**

- This Agreement centers into force on the day of its signature and will be valid for 5 years.
- If the parties, at least 6 months before expiration of this period, do not initiate the process to extend it, this Agreement would stand terminated.
- The Agreement can be terminated with a prior written notice of termination submitted by the 30th of June of the given year with effect at the end of that academic calendar year.

- All amendments to this Agreement are null and void unless made in writing.

Art. 7

- This Agreement has been two counterparts – one for each party.
