

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

RESIDENTIAL CAMP REPORT 2023-24

The National Service Scheme (NSS) of Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati, successfully conducted the Residential Labour Camp for the year 2023-24 at Shirala Village, Taluka and District Amravati, from February 1 to February 8, 2024. Various educational, social, intellectual, and skill-based activities were conducted during the camp for students and villagers. Key activities included workshops on new initiatives and technologies, Atal Twinkling Lab, Conversations about Space, "Be Fearless" sessions for students, robotics games, agriculture-related entrepreneurial guidance, self-help group workshops, social forestry, health diagnostic camps, and exhibitions showcasing historical artifacts and warfare equipment from the Shivaji era.

Daily activities included raising awareness about cleanliness through street plays, rallies, and waste management initiatives. Morning yoga sessions emphasized the importance of physical and mental health through yoga and pranayama. The camp offered students insights into essential aspects of rural life and their social responsibilities as citizens. Environmental awareness and the importance of maintaining cleanliness in personal surroundings were highlighted. Activities like bird watching helped students develop a sense of responsibility for the environment and the living beings around them.

Day 1: February 1, 2024 (Thursday)

The NSS team of 100 volunteers departed for Shirala village at 12:30 PM, carrying essential items such as tools for labour work and other supplies. The team reached the venue at 2:00 PM and cleaned the accommodation and event premises. The evening began with the NSS anthem and a prayer, followed by a meeting to plan the activities for the next day. The day concluded with dinner.

Day 2: February 2, 2024 (Friday)

The camp's inauguration ceremony was held on February 2, presided over by Shri Bhayyasaheb Patil Pusadkar, Vice-President of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati. Chief Guest Shri Nilesh Kadu, Regional Coordinator of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, and other dignitaries, including Shri Gajanand Korpe (Principal, Shri Shivaji Science College), Sarpanch Ankita Tayade, and others, were present. The ceremony concluded successfully with participation from volunteers and villagers.

Day 3: February 3, 2024 (Saturday)

The day started at 6:00 AM with prayers and devotional songs, followed by yoga and pranayama. After breakfast, the volunteers engaged in creating soak pits in the village as part of their labour work. Workshops for school students, including a robotics and drone technology session, were conducted with live demonstrations by Shri Mangesh Bhartiya

Group. In the afternoon, renowned poet Dr. Raju Shinde inspired students with a session on Swami Vivekananda's vision for youth. The day ended with rehearsals for street plays.

Day 4: February 4, 2024 (Sunday)

The fourth day began with regular morning routines, followed by labour work. A rath yatra (procession) in honor of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh and Sant Gadge Maharaj was organized to raise awareness about their contributions. Volunteers performed street plays on cyber security and cleanliness. Post-lunch, Dr. Manoj Sapkal delivered an insightful lecture on "Youth and Patriotism." In the evening, a documentary on Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh's life was screened at Gandhi Chowk, completing the day's activities.

Day 5: February 5, 2024 (Monday)

The day started with prayers and yoga. A workshop on agriculture for the village farmers was conducted with the participation of experts like Dr. Mangesh Dandge from Punjabrao Deshmukh Agricultural University, who discussed seasonal crops and vermicomposting. Evening sessions included poetry recitals by Dr. Swapnil Adsad and Prof. Sandeep Gawande.

Day 6: February 6, 2024 (Tuesday)

The sixth day featured a health check-up camp for women and children, organized with the support of the District Civil Hospital and Red Ribbon Club, Amravati. Tests for anemia and sickle cell disease were conducted. Afternoon sessions included discussions on superstitions by Prof. Kirti Kalmegh and a session on bird conservation by Dr. Gajanan Wagh, who explained the impact of climate change on bird species in Melghat.

Day 7: February 7, 2024 (Wednesday)

The morning started with a bird-watching session led by Dr. Gajanan Wagh. A lecture on "National Service Scheme and Social Values" by Prof. Suraj Hire emphasized practical values with live demonstrations. Another session on women's empowerment featured Prof. Dr. Sangeeta Ingole discussing financial independence, while Dr. Jayshree Dhote shared legal insights for women. The day concluded with cultural activities and prayers.

Day 8: February 8, 2024 (Thursday)

The final day began with the usual morning routine. The valedictory ceremony, presided over by Dr. Gajanand Korpe, included speeches by dignitaries, reflecting on the camp's accomplishments. Volunteers shared their experiences, highlighting how the camp shaped their perspectives and responsibilities. The camp ended with a sense of fulfillment and the team departed for Amravati.

The eight-day camp at Shirala village, filled with meaningful activities and learning experiences, concluded successfully. Volunteers contributed to societal and environmental welfare, gaining invaluable insights into their roles as responsible citizens.

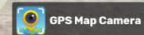
