Committee's Observations and Suggestions on Department wise Performance Score

B.Sc. Program

- ✓ As per the target score for B.Sc. program, few Departments failed to chase the target of 3.5. These departments are expected to be serious about their score and should improve it in next session.
- ✓ The departments are advised to identify the questions for which the score is below 3.5 and prepare the plan of action to improve their performance.
- ✓ The committee suggest that all departments should have to enhance outreach activities.
- ✓ The committee is of the opinion that average scores of '**Mentoring Support to Students**' and '**Students Learning Experience**' is sounding the alarm.

B.C.A. and B. Voc. Program

- ✓ As far as these UG programs are concern, students' satisfaction score for B.Voc. Program is quite higher than the target score. While it is unexpectedly lower for B.C.A. program.

M.Sc. Program

- ✓ As far as these PG programs are concern, students' satisfaction scores for M.Sc. Botany, Bioinformatics and Mathematics programs are alarming. The departments should have to develop their strategies to upgrade the score.

The committee has meticulously analysed the feedback from students concerning the Institute's Facilities and Support Services. As a result, we propose suggestions aimed at enhancing the overall quality, accessibility, and effectiveness of both facilities and support services. - ✓ Assess the efficiency and effectiveness of administrative and clerical support services offered to students.
- ✓ Analyze the performance, industry connections, and effectiveness of the placement cell in securing job opportunities for students.

Committee's Observations and Suggestions

Continuous evaluation and adjusting the CBCS system based on the feedback and experiences of teachers and students is crucial. It's an ongoing learning journey where making iterative changes can greatly improve the curriculum's effectiveness. The feedback collected from teachers regarding CBCS curriculum highlighted some significant concerns notably *the limited semester span that restricts the comprehensive exploration of the curriculum*. Additionally, there were suggestions for *incorporating value-added courses, enhancing soft skill training, and introducing domain-specific electives to enrich the educational experience*. Following are some specific observations and suggestions made by the feedback committee.

Observations:

- Teachers have noticed that students have varied learning paces and preferences.
- Creating assessments that fairly evaluate diverse learning choices can be complex.
- Certain courses or modules may require more resources or specific teaching methodologies.
- Ensuring that the chosen courses align with the overall learning objectives could be challenging.

Suggestions:

- Conduct pilot programs to test modifications before implementing them system-wide.
- Create platforms for teachers to share best practices, resources, and experiences with implementing CBCS.
