Under the joint initiative of the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra, and the Maharashtra Information Technology Support Centre, a “Career Katta” program was organized for the academic session 2024–25. As part of this initiative, a Career Parliament was established at Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati.

On this occasion, a grand ceremony for the oath-taking of the Career Parliament Cabinet, along with a “Career Opportunities: Student Interaction Platform” program, was held. The event was held on Wednesday, 14 August 2024, at 1:00 PM in the Matoshri Vimalabai Deshmukh Auditorium of the institution. During the ceremony, Nishant Hole took the oath as the Chief Minister (Head) of the Career Parliament, while eight other members took oath as Cabinet Ministers. The program was presided over by Dr. Dinesh Khedkar (Divisional and Institutional Coordinator, Career Katta). 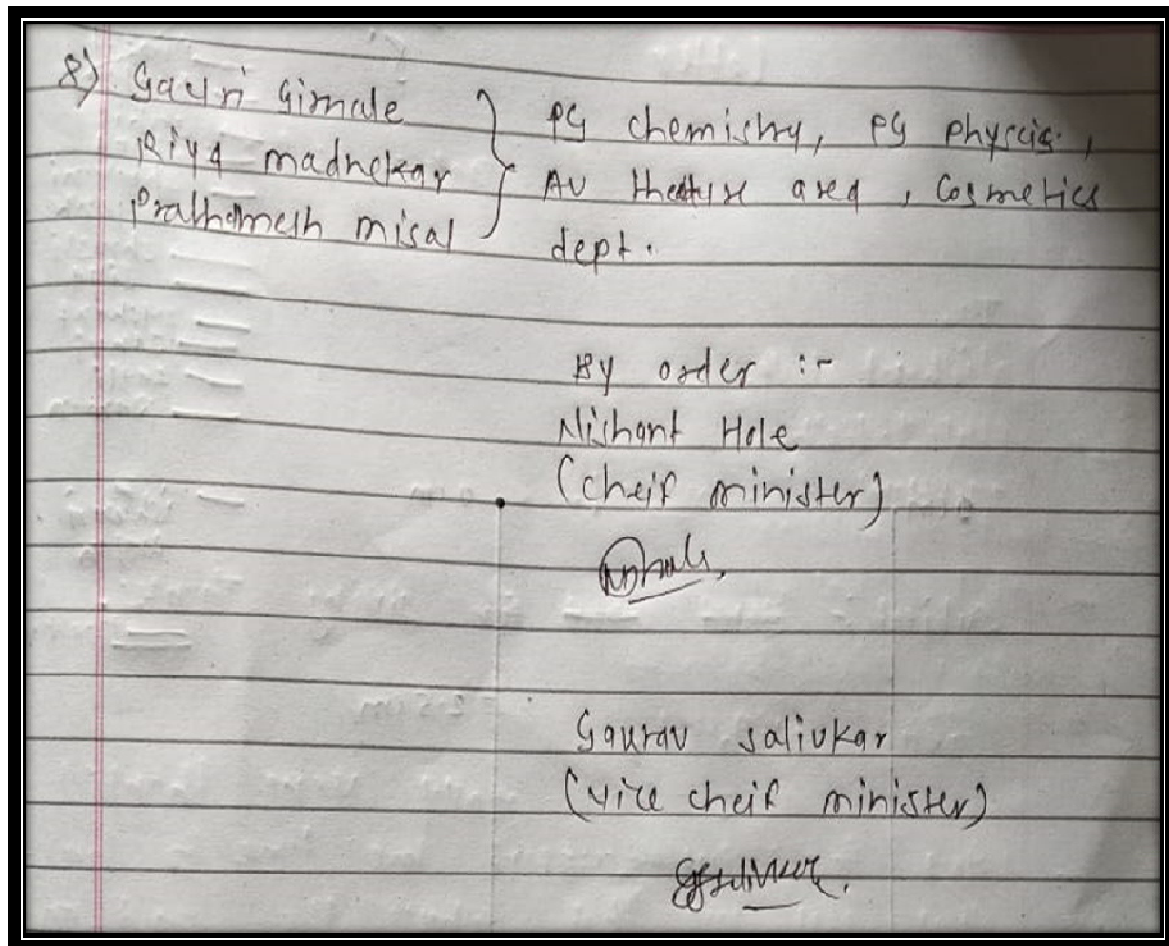
