In this connection, an undertaking in an affidavit that the funds so provided under the scheme will not be used for the Junior College, i.e. 10+1 and 10+2 classes.

It is further to inform you that you have to registered your college account in PFMS system under UGC Scheme code 0875 with documentary evidence.

In this regard, kindly submit the above required documents at the earliest to enable this office to release admissible grant to your college under the Scheme.




