2.4 Compulsory Dress Code

The uniform for girls and boys is available in students co-operative store of the college.

- Note : 1) It is compulsory to purchase college uniform from co-operative store only.
2) Students must attend the college in uniform only, violation will lead to disciplinary action.

2.5 Promotion :

Promotion from Std. XI to Std. XII will be on the average of the marks scored in the two Internal evaluation tests, home assignments and the two terminal examinations during the year. The promotion rules are as follows.

- 2.5.1 Minimum marks for passing in a subject are 35%.
- 2.5.2 Minimum marks for passing in theory are 20%. Minimum mark for passing in practical/oral are 20%. The candidate will have to appear for both the exams compulsorily due to separate passing in theory and practical/oral.
- 2.5.3 If a candidate who appears in all the subjects at one and the same examination fails in one or more subjects, and has deficiency of marks in one or at the most three subjects, he/she shall be condoned to a maximum of 15 marks in the aggregate, but not exceeding 10 marks in any one subject.
- 2.5.4 The result of Std. XI shall not be decided exclusively on the basis of the marks obtained in the annual examination. According to instructions from the Education Board, equal weightage shall be given to :
- First Terminal Examination
 - Second Terminal Examination and
 - Year work including practicals, unit tests, other assignments.

The final result of the students shall be decided on the average of the above three, i.e. $(a+b+c)/3$

- 2.5.5 There shall be no re-examination for the students who are declared unsuccessful.
- 2.5.6 All students promoted from Std. XI to Std. XII will have to fill in application forms as notified, to finalise/regularise their admission.



2.6 Higher Secondary Vocational Course (H.S.V.C.)

- २) या अभ्यासक्रमाचे स्वरूप सध्या जे व्यावसायिक अभ्यासक्रम (Vocational Course) कनिष्ठ महाविद्यालयातून शिकविल्या जात आहेत, त्यापेक्षा वेगळे आहे. हे अभ्यासक्रम राष्ट्रीय शैक्षणिक तथा अनुसंधान परिषदेने नवीन शैक्षणिक धोरणाच्या आराखड्याप्रमाणे तयार केलेले असून हा विद्यार्थी स्वयंरोजगारासाठी तथा उद्योग समूहात लागणारे किमान कौशल्य अभ्यासक्रमपूर्ण केल्यानंतर अंगी बाळगणारे आहे. हे किमान कौशल्य निवडलेल्या व्यवसायाकरिता परिपूर्ण तथा अंतिम स्वरूपाचे असावे हे उद्दिष्ट अभ्यासक्रमातून बाळगलेले आहे.
- ३) अमरावती जिल्ह्यातील औद्योगिक तथा व्यवसायिक गरजा लक्षात घेवून या महाविद्यालयात तीन अभ्यासक्रम सुरु आहेत.

- ५) हा अभ्यासक्रम पूर्ण करून झाल्यानंतर विद्यार्थ्यांना शिकाऊ उमेदवारी योजनेत एका वर्षाचे प्रशिक्षण देण्याची केंद्र शासन कायदाने व्यवस्था करित आहे त्यामुळे ज्या होतकरू विद्यार्थ्यांना स्वतंत्र उद्योगधंदा पुढील आयुष्यात अंगिकारायचा आहे. त्यांच्या दृष्टीने अभ्यासक्रम अतिशय महत्त्वाचे आहे.
- ६) शिक्षण शुल्क इतर संबंधित बाबींची अधिक माहितीपत्रकात दिली आहे.
- ७) बारावी उत्तीर्ण झाल्यानंतर कला, वाणिज्य आणि समाज कार्य (बी.एस.डब्ल्यू.) या विषयाकरिता प्रवेश घेता येतो.

- 3.1 Application in the prescribed form must be accompanied by **two recent stamp size photographs** and documents as mentioned in 4.3 (c)
- 3.2 Admissions are subject to the eligibility norms of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education.
- 3.3 Application will be considered only when it fulfills the following conditions :
- It is properly and correctly filled and signed by the applicant & applicant's father/guardian.
 - It is received by the college office on or before the last date prescribed.
 - It is accompanied by the attested copies of the following documents.
 - School/College Leaving Certificate (T.C.)
 - Statement of marks of the last examination passed/failed.
 - Migration Certificate in case of a person who has passed the last examination from a Board other than Maharashtra State Board.
 - Caste certificate, Validity and Non Creamy Layer
 - Aadhar Card
- 3.4 Students who pass the qualifying examination from any other Board/University and desire to seek admission should submit an eligibility certificate.
- 3.5 Applicants who have a break in education should submit a gap certificate in the form of a court affidavit stating the reason for the gap.
- 3.6 Applicants will be required to surrender the original copy of their School/College leaving certificate at the time of finalisation of admission.
- 3.7 Duplicate T.C. (Transfer Certificate) will not be entertained.**
- 3.8 Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to backward classes will be according to the government regulations and circulars.

SECTION - 6 : General Information

6.1 Academic result :

College results from last five years are consistently good which are the basis of its strong foundation. As a consequence a large number of students are getting attracted to this college for admission.

6.2 Attendance :

In order to qualify for the Board/University examinations, concessions and scholarships students must attend atleast 75% of the lectures (including practicals) delivered in each subject.

Students who fall short of the required attendance do not qualify for any type of fee concession/scholarship. Such students will have to pay full fees.

A monthly attendance record will be displayed regularly for the information of students, so that they may makeup the shortfall of attendance.

Strict disciplinary action, leading to detention from appearing in examination shall be taken.

WARNING - No relaxation will be given to students who fall short of attendance in classes.

6.3 Identity Card (Bar-coded) :

All the students of the college shall have to wear the identity card compulsorily during college hours on the college premises, failing which action will be taken. Students are advised to collect the I-card from the admission committee.

6.4 College Examinations :

All students will have to compulsorily appear for the unit tests as per schedule notified by examination committee.

6.5 Principal's address :

The Principal's address will be arranged in the month of August. All the students should attend it compulsorily as per the schedule declared.

6.6 Library & Reading Room :

The college possesses a well-stocked and fast-growing library. The library has installed SOUL 2.0 version software for Library automisation. There are more than 36,383 books, 16 journals 2396 bound volumes and 895 reference books. On-line data base and consortia can be asses from department password. The university question paper and research paper is available on library website <http://shivajilibrary.com>.



Students admitted to the college can become member of the library by filling up online membership from the library website. The library provides OPAC (On line Public Access Catalogue) through which users can browse the status of documents & members. The library has procured the latest bar-code equipment to digitalise book cataloguing and identification. Students are expected to borrow books in accordance with rules made for the purpose. The Reading Room is provided with a large number of reference books, science journals, periodicals, scientific abstracts, general magazines, and news papers in English, Marathi, Hindi. An independent reading-room is provided for post-graduate students. A separate library committee ensures smooth functioning. Library Timing 7 am to 6.10 pm on working days.

6.7 Network Resource Centre (NRC) :

The college has a full-fledged Network Resource Centre (NRC) with computers and internet facility. All the stake holders should take advantage of this facility. For details contact the librarian.

6.8 Girls' Common Room :

The college has a girls common room with basic amenities, on the first floor, near Physics department. For details contact Prof.-in-charge.

6.9 Communication Skill Programs :

In order to develop communication skill/spoken English, college has hi-tech language laboratory facility. For details contact Prof.-in-charge Ms. P. V. Barabde of the Language Department.

6.10 Remedial Coaching for Backward Class Students :

The college runs a remedial coaching scheme for academically weak undergraduate and post graduate students including those of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

The college runs a career employment guidance bureau & placement cell for guiding the students to choose their career course for higher studies & for their personality development & job placement. Students should contact Prof.-in-charge for more details.

6.12 Test Series for Entrance Examination for Professional Courses :

College has advanced, wellinformed, wellequipped MHT-CET/JEE/NEET guidance and coaching cell & runs test series for these exams.

6.13 Guardian Teacher Scheme :

On joining the college each student is placed under the personal supervision and guidance of a teacher who acts as a friend, philosopher and mentor, and keeps a record of the students' progress. For details contact Prof.-in-charge of the scheme.

6.14 Student Grievance Redressal Cell :

A students grievance redressal cell takes care of general grievances of students. For details contact Prof. in-charge.

**6.15 Monitoring in College Campus :**

The College Campus is monitored by teachers daily, shift-wise, to ensure the smooth running of the College and to curb outsiders' disturbance. Trespassers are not allowed. Students are advised to cooperate with the monitoring committee by wearing I-Cards and dissuading their friends from frequently visiting the College.

6.16 College Magazine/Wall Magazine :

College magazine "Shivsmriti" and wall magazine "Akshar Parimal" are run by an editorial board consisting of members of staff and students who have a flair for writing. This gives an opportunity for self expression to the students in Marathi, Hindi, Urdu and English.

6.17 Games & Sports :

The College encourages students to participate in various games and sports. We have facilities for athletics, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Badminton, Table Tennis, Ball-badminton, Basket-ball, Cricket, Chess, Volley-ball, Softball, Lawn tennis, Netball, Cricket & Baseball for boys & girls.

Deserving sports persons receive every encouragement from the college. The college participates in University sports and other recognised tournaments. The college produces a good number of University colour holders every year in Amravati University Inter Collegiate Tournaments. Members of various teams must report punctually for daily practice for matches, otherwise facilities & incentive will be withdrawn. Any player who has been punished for indiscipline in college will be withdrawn from the team. and will not be eligible for sports prizes or college/university colours. 6.18 Gymnasium :

The college provides a modern gymnasium with all the facilities to its stake holders. Interested persons should contact the Physical Education Department for details.

6.22 Students' Co-operative Stores :

The college runs a Co-operative Stores to meet the stationery needs of students. Purchasing practicals record books from the co-operative stores is compulsory. Each student has to become a nominal member of the co-operative stores on payment of the prescribed fee.

6.23 Students' College Entry & Vehicle Stand :

Students should enter in the college only by gate No. 2 and they should park their Vehicles at the back side of the college, failing which they will be penalised. Newly constructed Cycle Stand in front of the Girls' Hostel is exclusively for girl students.

6.24 Suggestion Box :

**SECTION - 7 : Rules & Regulations and code of conduct for students**

- 7.1** Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
- 7.2** The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board of the college.
- 7.3** The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case a student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
- 7.4** Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per University rules.
- 7.5** No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
- 7.6** All new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the University. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the University. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.
- 7.7** Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indisciplined manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.
- 7.8** Students should behave respectfully with all staff members at college and politely with their fellow students, including girls. Any act of disobedience, improper and discourteous exchange of words or indecent remarks, especially at girl students, is a punishable offence and will be viewed seriously.
- 7.9** Students should make careful use of college books, room furniture, fans, laboratory equipment and college property in general. The cost of damage done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
- 7.10** Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom, Students, therefore, should



see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.

- 7.11** No student shall send any information concerning the college for publication either to the press or elsewhere without prior approval of the Principal of the college, nor shall he/she approach the President or the L.M.C. Members except through the college Principal. Any breach of this rule may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.
- 7.12** The students should not roam in corridors, or play during working hours or free classes, Instead, they should utilise the library and reading room facilities.
- 7.13 *Smoking, gutkalpaan chewing and ragging are strictly prohibited. Offenders are liable to face legal action.***
- 7.14** Students are prohibited from forming associations/organisations and from holding functions in the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 7.15** Students are prohibited from organising welcome and farewell and other such functions outside college premises. Violation shall attract severe disciplinary action.
- 7.16** Any change of address must be notified to the college office immediately.
- 7.17** For details of the curriculum refer to the syllabi of the Education Board/University, as the case may be.
- 7.18** The students carry the responsibility of maintaining cleanliness on the campus. Dust bins have been provided at suitable places for this purpose. Any one found littering the college premises or spitting on the wall or causing any dirtiness will be severely penalized.
