Figure 1 Shows the alumni response about the pre stated course objectives. 100 % respondents are of opinion that the course objectives were very clear.






Figure 2 shows the alumni response for number of periods due to engage and their time table was manageable or not. Here also, all respondents were agree that their time table was manageable.








Figure 4 shows students response against the skills they acquire after completion of the course. Here about 31 % students felt that expected competencies were gain by them but about 69 % students said it is Good.
