4. Brief outlines of the thematic genesis of the project and the over-all approach followed for its implementation as approved by the NCSTC.

i. Brief objective of the project

The main objectives of this project are:

The aim of present research is to develop an advanced fabrication method for applications of biosensors, including the development of deposition of polymers like Chitosan (CH), Poly-vinyl alcohol (PVA) and enzymes like Urease (Ur), Horseradish peroxidase and Lipase as well as the NiFe_2O_4 , TiO_2 , CuO , MgO nanoparticles.

This refers to your pre-proposal under the Scheme “Science and Innovation Activity Centres” of the Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Commission and the discussion during the meeting on **Friday, 19th May, 2015, at Institute of Chemical Technology, Mumbai**, for preliminary scrutiny of the pre-proposals received under the Scheme.

The Principal Coordinators from the institutions were requested to make presentations giving the salient features of their proposals, strength of the institution, arrangement for long term sustainable operation of the centre, suitability of the location for use by the schools in the area etc. However, the presentations made, and the discussion that followed, left an impression that certain additional clarifications need to be made at this stage for better appreciation of the scheme.

Although the broad features of the facilities to be provided have been given in the scheme document, following additional points may please be noted.

1. The primary objective of setting up “Science and Innovation Activity Centre” is to inculcate a spirit of scientific enquiry to address curiosity among students about different scientific concepts. This would need to be done through sustained mentoring that helps students to ask right questions and find their answers including where necessary through conduct of experiments specifically designed for the purpose. Emphasis should be on imbibing a culture of innovation and activity based learning by school students.
2. This would be a year round activity for the students from the neighborhood in a time sharing mode. The facility should enable self-learning of science through access to resources like laboratories, library, online and offline digital resources, workshop etc. apart from mentoring support and an atmosphere of discussion. Exploratory, Pune; Bajaj Science Centre, Wardha and the Science Centre in Sindhudurg District are facilities that are pursuing such an approach.
3. It has been suggested that Principal Coordinators and key individuals likely to be involved in shaping your “Science and Innovation Activity Centre” should visit some or all of above institutions to get an idea of diverse approaches to learning science.


4. To be hosted by a school/school education institution, the centre is expected to also cater to the students from the neighbouring schools and should be easily accessible to them.
5. The autonomous management of the centre, its long term financial sustainability and its locational advantage would be crucial issues and should be clearly brought out in the detailed proposals.

In order to provide a greater insight into the scheme and also bring in conceptual clarity, a Week Long Workshop is proposed to be arranged at Mumbai and/or Pune by July 2015 for representatives of the institutions that were shortlisted during the meeting. Two key representatives, one of which shall be the Principal Coordinator, from each institution would participate in the proposed Workshop. The Workshop will be arranged jointly by the Nehru Science Centre, Mumbai; Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education, Mumbai; Exploratory, Pune and Vidnyan Ashram, Pune. This would help the institutions in giving shape to their detailed project proposals. The exact programme would be worked out soon and communicated well in advance.

We thank you for taking keen interest in the scheme and hope that the proposal would take proper shape without losing individual identity. A well evolved proposal has a better chance of success and potential for replication at other institutions.







Creation of Scientific temper in the people is an important element of the National Science Policy. While the formal education system looks after the science education and curriculum improvements are routinely attempted at all levels, a need is recognized for non-formal and activity linked science education. Those who wish to learn more need to be provided facilities such as resource material and guidance. This would help in stimulating innovative skills and entrepreneurial talent.

2. To encourage these much needed complementary activities, the Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Commission has launched a Scheme “Science Innovation Activity Centres” for implementation at suitable educational institutions that are ready to take full responsibility of operating such centres on a long term and sustainable basis. These Centres would not only cater to the students of the host institutions but would also cater to the students of other schools in the adjacent region.

3. Based on the extensive interaction and the spade work done for the scheme, the Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Commission has now signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati, for setting up of Science and Innovation Activity Centre at its Campus at Amravati. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 2.50 crore out of which the Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Commission would provide 75% and the host institution would provide 25%. The host institution would also provide land and infrastructural facilities as specified in the scheme and also take the responsibility of operating the Centre on a long term and sustainable basis.

4. The project is to be implemented by the National Council for Science Museums (NCSM), Govt. of India, Kolkata, on a turnkey basis. A Memorandum of Understanding to this effect is already signed with NCSM and the Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education, Mumbai.

5. The Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Commission is, therefore, pleased to sanction setting up of Science and Innovation Activity Centre at the campus of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati, as specified in the scheme and the MoU and release an amount of Rs. 93,75,000/- (Rs. Ninety Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) as the first instalment (which is 50% of RGSTC share Rs. 1,87,50,000/-) to National Council for Science Museums, Kolkata, for implementation of the project. Shri Shivaji Education Society shall also release, through RGSTC, its share of Rs. 31,25,000/- (Rs. Thirty One Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand Only) (which is 50% of the institute share of Rs. 62,50,000/-) to NCSM, Kolkata as the first instalment. The work plan should be finalised immediately to initiate implementation of the project. The amount of Rs. 93,75,000/- (Rs. Ninety Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) shall be transferred directly to NCSM Bank A/C with Indian Overseas Bank, Sector-V, Salt Lake, Kolkata. NCSM is requested to acknowledge receipt of the payment immediately.

6. The progress of implementation would be monitored by a Monitoring Committee to be constituted by the Commission. The Committee would be serviced by the National Council for Science Museums. A separate order to this effect would be issued shortly. The NCSM should provide periodic progress report and Utilization Certificate to enable the Commission to complete the reviewing process.
