

#### Amravati City

#### One- Day Workshop On 'NAAC: New Methodology of Assessment on 26th March, 2019'

In view of the new methodology of NAAC assessment which is effective from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017, the management of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati had decided to organize a workshop on new process of preparing AQAR and SSR for NAAC. - ✓ Its compatibility with windows, iOS and Android operating systems.
- ✓ How one can easily find time for classroom preparation using his smart-phone, tablet or PC.
- ✓ One can maintain his lessons on any device, since it is always synchronized with Chalk
- ✓ It's free for individual teachers.
- ✓ Only prerequisite is a personal gmail account.

Presenter has also trained the faculty to create their account on Clalk/Planboard, create the semesters, add the subjects, manage the time table, manage the lesson planning, create the class wise student attendance, adding the holidays and personal leave record.

Dr. H S. Lunge explained about the new RAF process of assessment of HEI published recently by NAAC. The new methodology is based on the digitised documents for the

different claims made by the institutions on all seven criteria. The new process includes qualitative and quantitative based evaluation on various metrics. 70% evaluation through system generated on quantitative metrics and 305 on qualitative metrics through PT visit. The time bound programmes is also published by NAAC.
